ON VISION & CALLING

BECAUSE OUR WORK IS NOT SEPARATE FROM GOD'S PURPOSES.

Proverbs 29:18 (NIV)

Where there is no revelation, people cast off restraint; but blessed is the one who heeds wisdom's instruction.

Habakkuk 2:2 (NIV)

Then the LORD replied: "Write down the revelation and make it plain on tablets so that a herald may run with it."

Proverbs 16:3 (NIV)

Commit to the LORD whatever you do, and he will establish your plans.

Malachi 3:10-11 (NIV)

Test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it. I will prevent pests from devouring your crops, and the vines in your fields will not drop their fruit before it is ripe," says the Lord Almighty.

Mark 12:41-44 (NIV)

Jesus sat down opposite the place where the offerings were put and watched the crowd putting their money into the temple treasury. Many rich people threw in large amounts. But a poor widow came and put in two very small copper coins, worth only a few cents.

Calling his disciples to him, Jesus said, "Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put more into the treasury than all the others. They all gave out of their wealth; but she, out of her poverty, put in everything—all she had to live on."

Matthew 10:8 (NIV)

Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy, drive out demons. Freely you have received; freely give.
